This HSE Policy apply to project management, design, development, manufacturing, installation, commissioning, maintenance and operation of railways, mass-transit systems and tramways, including signalling, on board vehicle control, passenger information systems, communication systems, power supply and related equipment and components belonging to Ansaldo STS Branch of Peru managing areas and services.

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY

- to increase training and information activities for all workers, with the aim of increasing their awareness of the risks connected to their activity;
- to continue to develop activities in support of the spreading of a safety culture vis-à-vis all the suppliers and parties involved.

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY


